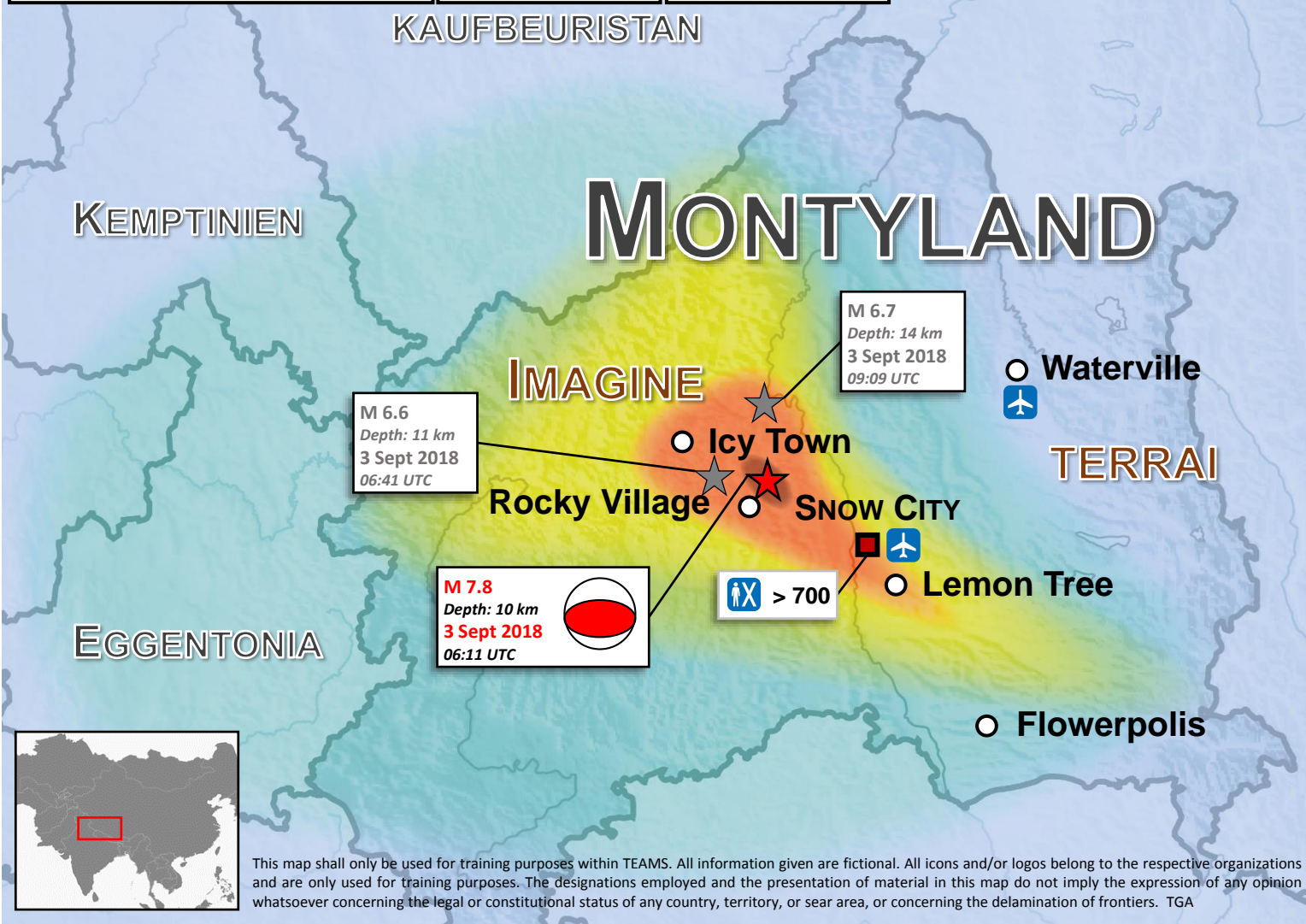


Montyland | 7.8 M Earthquake of 3 September

An earthquake of magnitude 7.8 Mw at a depth of 10.48 km hit Montyland on 3 September at 06:11 UTC 80km North West of the capital Snow City. The earthquake affected 30 of 75 districts and was also felt in the neighboring countries. The Greater Snow City Area as well as the districts of Icy Town and Rocky Village are most affected. As of 3 September, 2.000 people are reported dead, mostly in the Snow City area. At least 6.000 people are reported injured. Search and rescue operations are still on-going. International assistance has been requested. *Source: humedica*
